This trip will wrap up our economics unit. We began our study of economics in February. In first grade, we teach economics with the objectives that students will:

- Distinguish between producers and consumers of goods and services.

- Be able to explain why people cannot have everything they want (scarcity) and describe how people respond to that problem (choice).
- Describe ways in which people earn money (providing goods and services to others).
- Describe how money simplifies trade.
